



## Albert M. Greenfield School Uniform Policy



### Shirts

Shirts must have a collar (pointed, round, polo or turtleneck), reach the waist, and be one of the following solid colors: **Navy, light blue, or white**

- *Patterns, stripes, or other designs are NOT permitted.*
- Greenfield logo shirts and Greenfield T-shirts are permitted at any time.
- Greenfield attire can be purchased during the *1<sup>st</sup> Day of School* in the play yard, the 1<sup>st</sup> day of kindergarten at *Coffee and Commiseration* in the library, or at the *Garden Party* (a Friday in September). Order forms will also be sent home in September.

### Bottoms

Pants must start at the waist and stay there. Shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be knee-length and made of the same material as uniform pants. They must be one of the following colors: **Navy or khaki**

- **Denim of any color is NOT permitted except on Dress-Down Days.**

### Shoes

Shoes must be closed-toed and closed-back and worn at all times. No sandals or crocs will be permitted.

### Outerwear

Students may not wear hoodies, sweatshirts, sweaters, jackets, coats, hats, etc. inside the building during the school day. Plain navy blue cardigans are permitted on cold days.

### NEVER PERMITTED—Not even on Dress-Down-Days:

Hoodies, tank tops, revealing or torn clothing, spandex or other skin-tight clothing, tights or leggings without skirts/dresses, slippers or sandals

### Consequences for Non-Compliance

*1<sup>st</sup> Infraction:* Phone call to inform parent

*4<sup>th</sup> Infraction:* In-school suspension

*2<sup>nd</sup> Infraction:* Lunch detention

*5<sup>th</sup> Infraction and beyond:* Out-of-

*3<sup>rd</sup> Infraction:* After-school detention

School suspension
